

## Director's Message

In 2019 the Chili Public Library continued to create innovative programs and provide new services to those in the community. The Library added an OverDrive Advantage feature to its Monroe County Library System OverDrive account, which offers popular titles exclusively to our Chili patrons. The Library's New York State Summer Reading Program 'A Universe of Stories!' was quite successful, with over 568 children participating and reading 209,440 minutes over the summer months, and our Youth Services staff promoted the program to over 1,575 students at the local schools. The Library created a new Roaring 20's & 30's Library Group for adults in their 20s and 30s, and offered programs geared specifically to that age group. The Library collaborated with the Chili Lions Club and the Alzheimer's Association in providing adult programs of special interest. The Library's Makerspace Room began to offer open hours on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. A new fishing rod lending service in partnership with the DEC was offered to our patrons. Improvements to the Library's website were made and its social media presence expanded with the creation of the Friends of the Chili Public Library Facebook page. In mid-year the Library took part in the Chili Community Center groundbreaking, and looks forward to seeing this project to its completion. It is through the efforts of the Library Board, staff, volunteers, and the support from the Town of Chili and its residents that the Chili Public Library continues to be a welcoming center of lifelong education.

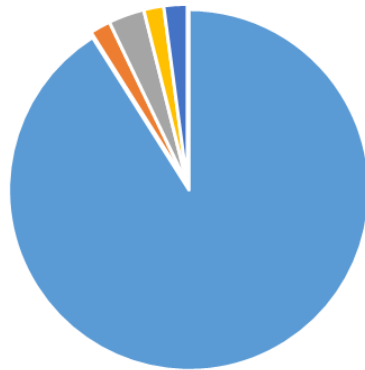

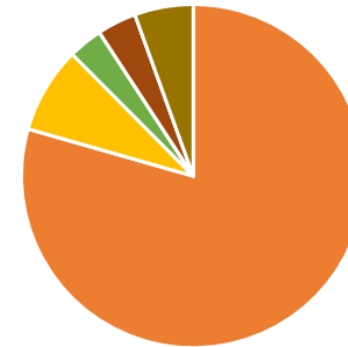

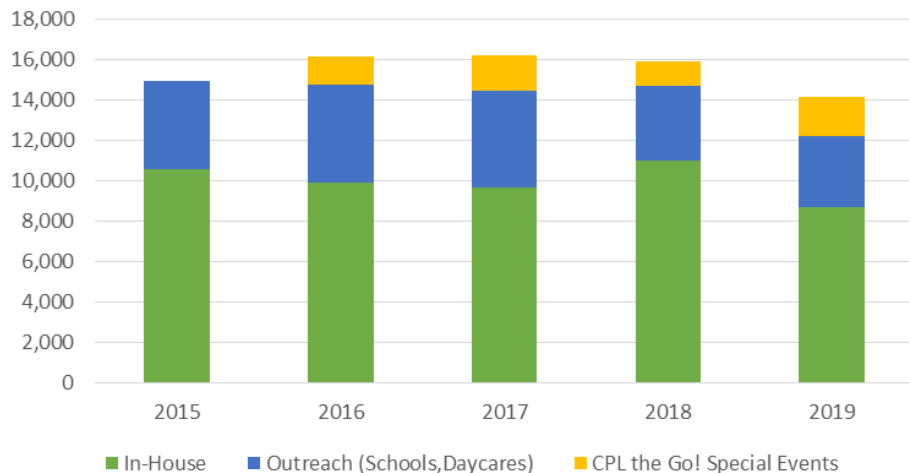
