2021 was a special year for the Chili Public Library. The Library confidently navigated through the COVID crises by producing quality virtual programs for patrons of all ages, increased substantially our digital OverDrive and Hoopla collections, and continued to provide curbside service as an additional way to access the collection.

These activities alone merit recognition, but the highlight of the year was the Library moving into the new Chili Community Center. Those who have visited the new Library since the grand opening on May 15, 2021 are impressed to see an attractive interior with large windows bringing in natural light. A two sided fireplace greets those that enter the library, and there is a welcoming Reading Room that showcases the artwork from the Chili Art Group, and historical images from the Town historian. The new Library facility also has enough shelving to allow for the collection to grow. Teens enjoy their own space in an enclosed Teen Room, and children discover the joy of reading in the enlarged Children's Room with heated floor, and play area. Unique to the Library is the 1,000 square foot Spark Lab, the place to go to spark one's imagination. During the Spark Lab open hours the Library assist those in using the Library's 3D printer, Cricut, sewing machines, and more. The Library staff, Library Board, and volunteers look forward to providing for the needs of the community in the years to come.

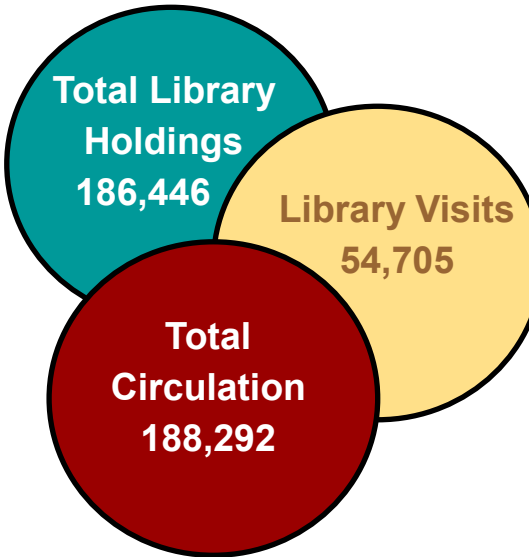
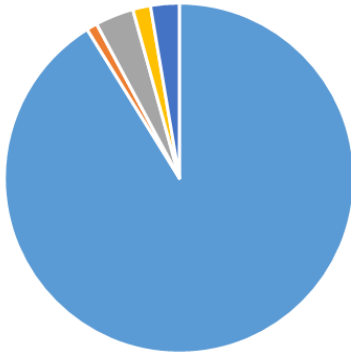

Fund Receipts

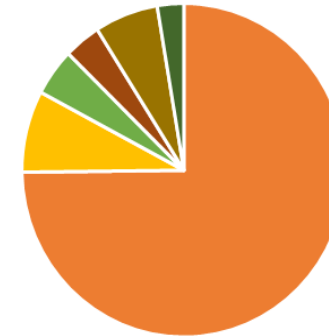
- Chili Local Taxes: \$1,129,537

TOTAL DISBURSMENTS: \$1,239,019

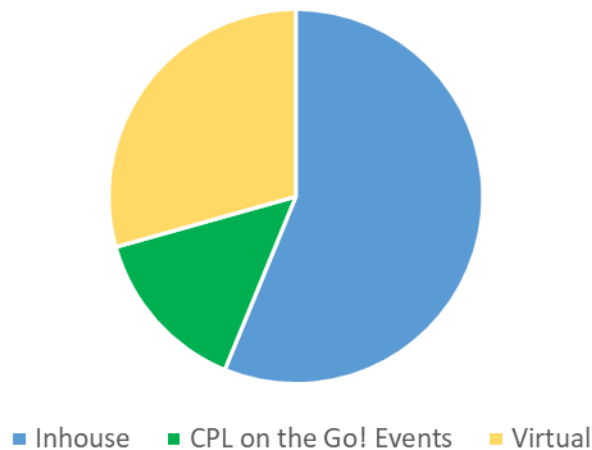
