Director's Message

The Chili Public Library flourished in 2022. We added shelving for our growing picture book collection, and built upon the Library's special collections (Parenting, Homeschooling, Job Information, Seniors, and Steam-To-Go). More residents used our digital collection, and to better serve our patrons, the loan period for DVDs increased to three weeks instead of one. We also added a new format Wonderbooks which benefits those with visual impairments.

The Director and Library Board created a new long range plan. Our new location allowed us to take advantage of the expanded space within the Chili Community Center, which serves as a center of community engagement The Summer Reading Program was extremely successful with our patrons reading a total of 384,000 minutes! We also began a new Tween Book Club called "Comics Count" focusing on graphic novels, and for the Town's Bicentennial, the Library created a Town of Chili timeline, and provided multiple programs about the history of our area.

The open hours of the Library's Spark Lab Makerspace Room continued to be popularly used. Equipment in the Spark Lab was updated and additional Spark Kits were lent out to patrons.

The Library staff, Library Board, and volunteers look forward to providing for the needs of the community in the years to come.
