

Materials Selection Inquiry Form

For this reason, we are providing a procedure for the public to inquire about the selection of library materials.

Questions regarding the library's collection development policy should be referred to a librarian. If, following discussion with the librarian, the patron's concern(s) remain unresolved, the patron will be provided a "Materials Selection Inquiry Form." No inquiry will be considered without name, address and phone number included. Upon receipt of the completed form, the Library Director will thoroughly review it and respond in writing to the patron. If the patron is not satisfied with the response, the matter may be presented to the Library Board of Trustees for its final review.
